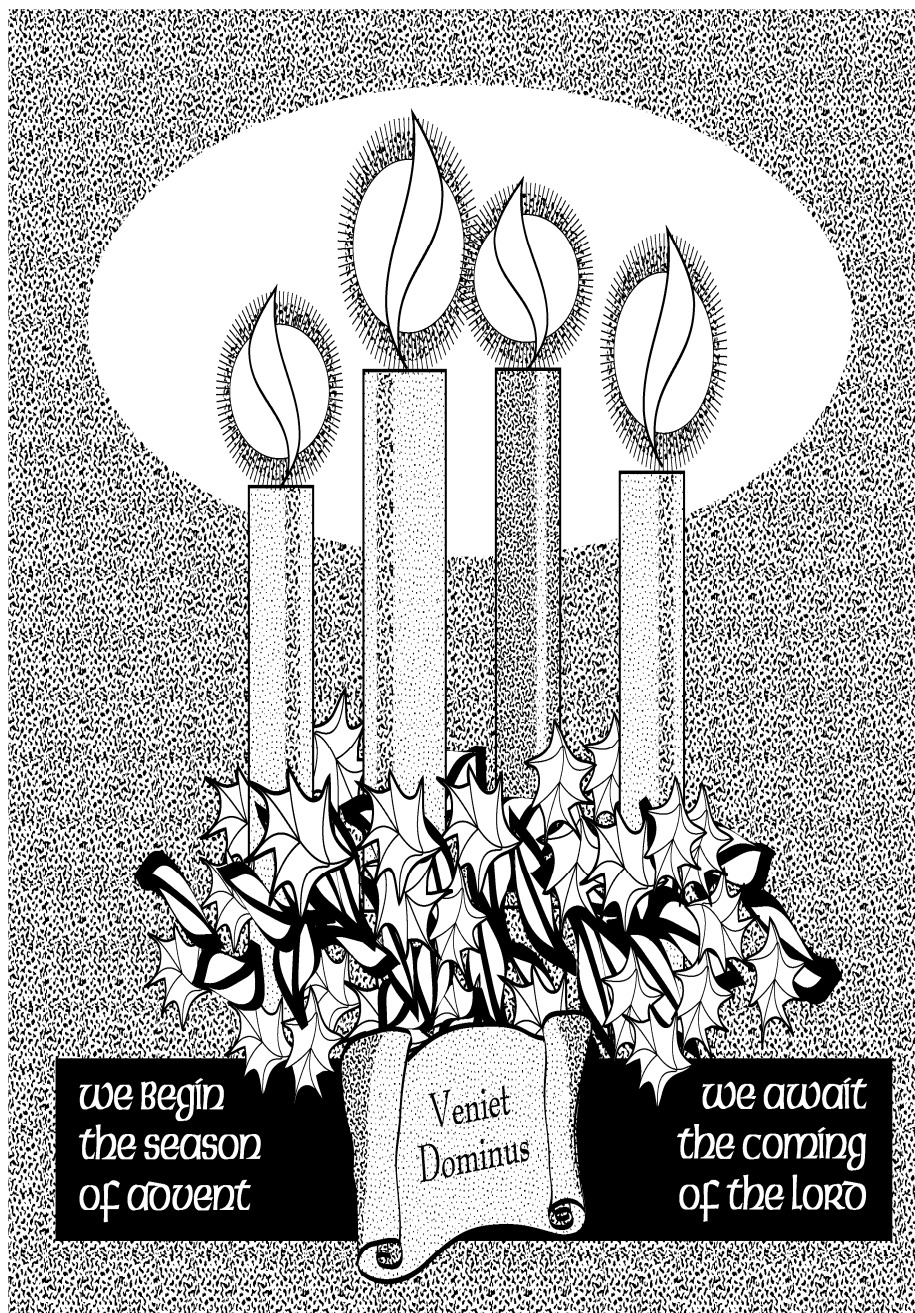

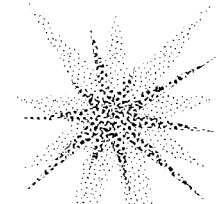

Pray this prayer with your family beginning on St. Andrew's Feast Day (November 30th) until Christmas day. Try to pray it 15 times a day!

DID YOU KNOW?

The CARES ACT provided a charitable giving incentive.

It established a new, above-the-line deduction (universal or non-itemized deduction that applies to all taxpayers) for total charitable contributions of up to \$300. The incentive applies to contribution made in 2020 and would be claimed on tax forms next year. The bill also lifted the existing cap on annual contributions for those who itemize, raising it from 60 percent of adjusted gross income to 100 percent. Consult with your tax advisor.

ST. BERNARD'S SCHOOL Is OPEN!



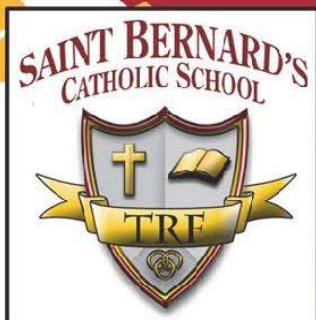
For the past eight months we have been tackling the problem of the COVID epidemic. How do we react? How can we effectively teach while at a distance? How do we prepare for safe in-person learning? How can we utilize all the data in which to guide our decisions?

While we do not have just one data point to decide the learning plan for St. Bernard's, there have been a variety of factors such as the COVID rate per 10,000 in Pennington County, ages of positive cases, number of positive / quarantine cases at St. Bernard's, available staff members, and other factors.

Over the past few weeks, all the numbers have been raising which then triggered a discussion of the faculty, staff, and School Advisory Council (SAC) members as to the immediate learning direction of St. Bernard's School.

We have decided to continue with in person learning.

We will do our best to ride out this wave while maintaining a safe environment for our students and staff.
